School Holiday Fun at Y Water


As another school term comes to a close no doubt both parents, and grandparents, will be looking out for activities to keep their primary age offspring and grandies amused during the winter school holidays.


Well look no more as the Y Water Discovery Centre in Yea has two wonderful events planned for the Wednesday mornings which will entertain and inform your children.
