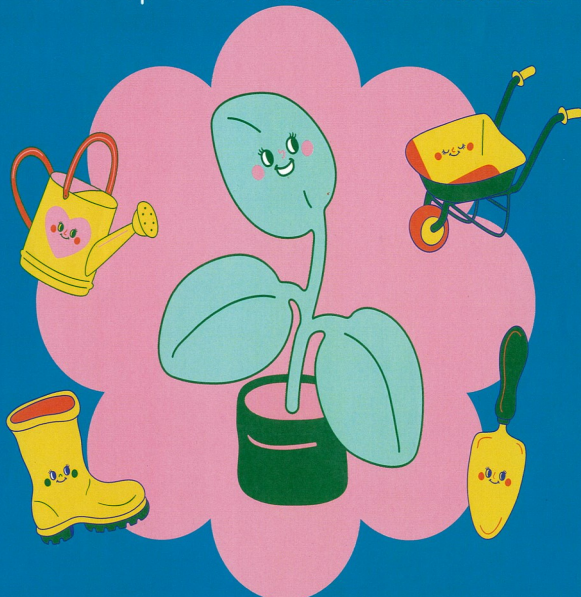
New Chickens

On Thursday 25th two baby chickens hatched. They were wet and soggy on the first day. Now they are cute and fluffy Silver Wyandottes. **Max**



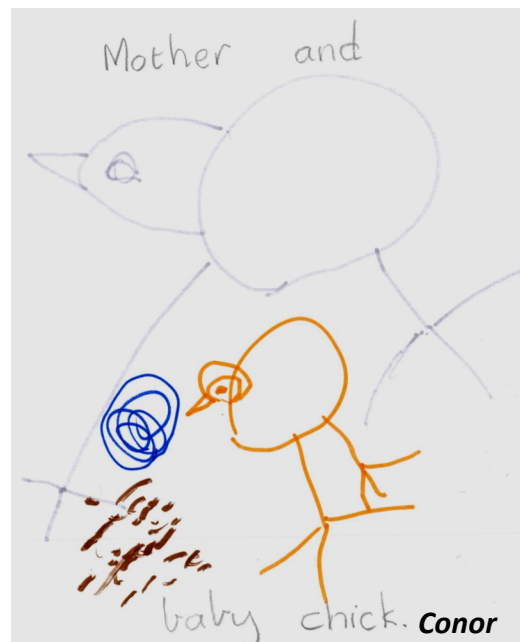
TWILIGHT WORKING BEE
